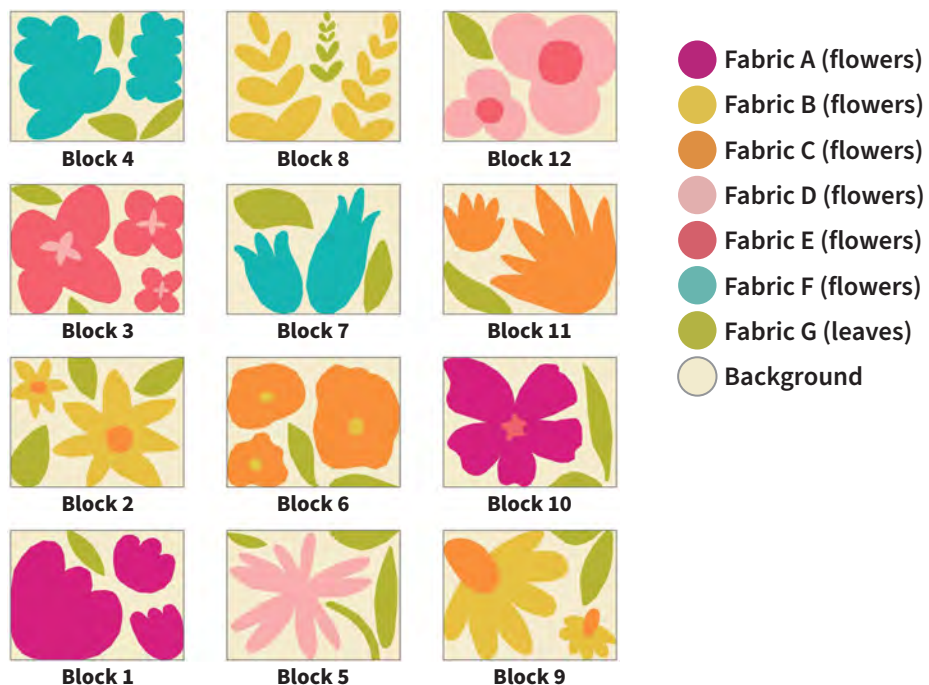




materials for individual Wildflower Remix Blocks 1-12

Yardage is based on 42" width of fabric.

INDIVIDUAL FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Fabric requirements below are based on pre-cutting all fabric with dimensions supplied in the individual pattern cutting charts. Each block will list requirements for each type of fabric — these amounts will account for a bit extra in case of a minor cutting mistake and are rounded up to a common yardage cut. **Depending on your paper piecing skills and piecing style, you may use more or less fabric.**

Collect all of your fabric ahead of time, gather fabric as you make blocks, or use what you have and make it scrappy!

IMPORTANT: The overall fabric requirements listed below are based on making individual blocks only.

Fabric requirements when making all Blocks 1-12 for Runner/Quilt Options A1, A2, B1, B2, C, and D are listed in the cumulative fabric requirements on subsequent pages. The cumulative fabric requirements assume that there will be some fabric leftover after piecing each block. You are also likely to have scraps that can be used in subsequent blocks.

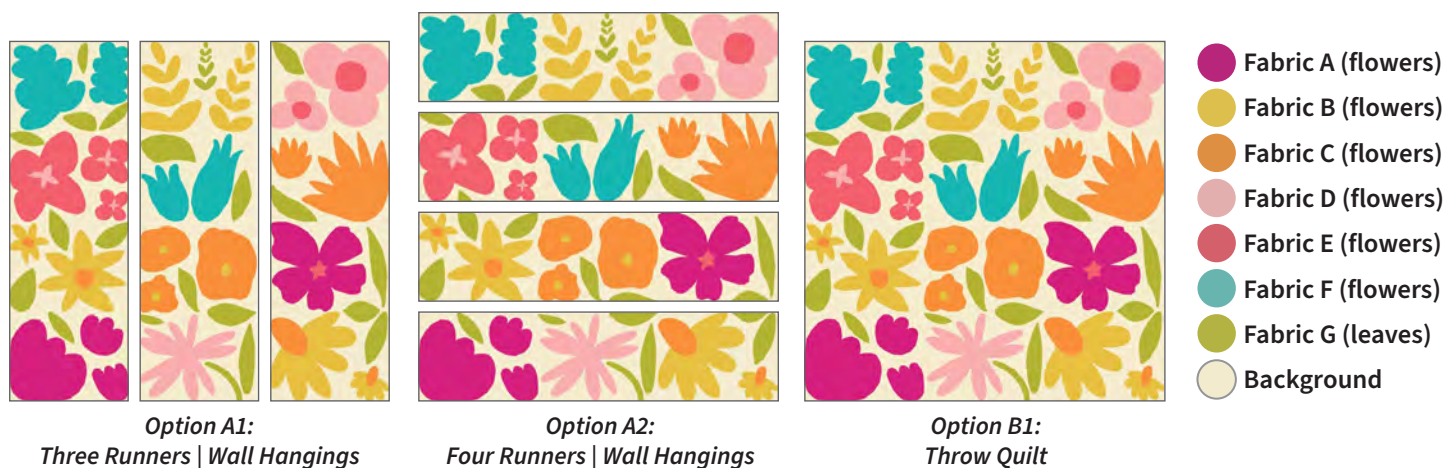

3 Runners each measuring 20½" x 60½" **OR** 4 Runners each measuring 60½" x 15½" **OR** Throw Quilt measuring 60½" x 60½"

Backing Fabric: 4 3⁄4 yds | Batting: 28½" x 68½" (qty 3) | Binding Fabric: 1 yd

Backing Fabric: 5 1⁄4 yds | Batting: 68½" x 23½" (qty 4) | Binding Fabric: 1 1⁄4 yds

Backing Fabric: 3 3⁄8 yds | Batting: 68½" x 68½" | Binding Fabric: 5⁄8 yd
